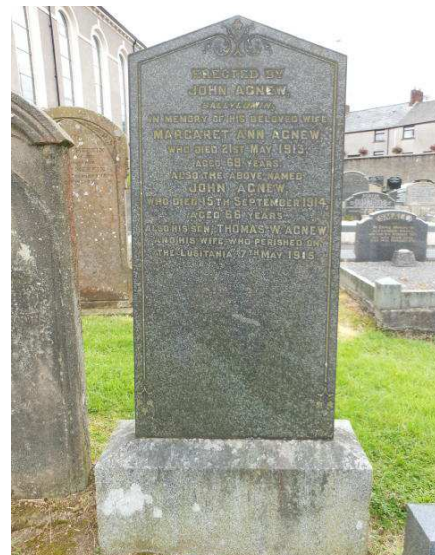

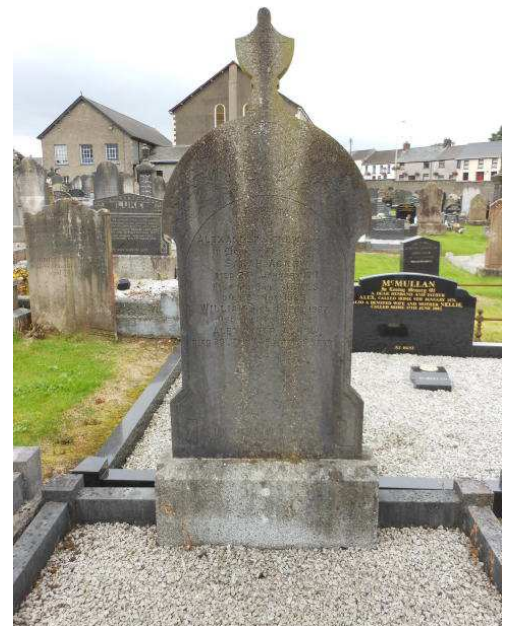

Agnew 1st Ahoghill 1876 In Memory of **William Agnew**, Ballybeg, who died 13th May 1900 aged 55 years His eldest daughter **Janie** who died 9th October 1876 aged 1 year and 7 months And his wife **Charlotte Higginson** born December 24th 1848 died January 4th 1936

Agnew 1st Ahoghill 1866 In memory of **James Agnew** of Ballybeg who departed this life 8th November 1866 aged 59 years And his wife **Jane** who departed this life 17th January 1889 aged 82 years
